

# Foreign Language

## **Foreign Language I- 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>**

This class is devoted to the development of the basic skills in oral comprehension, speaking, reading, writing, and the development of cultural knowledge. Students have the opportunity to hear and see native speakers through the audio/visual components of the program. Lessons consist of vocabulary development in context through comprehensive input (news clips, video clips), dialogs, reading selections, conversations in the target language and culturally related projects.

By the end of this course, students will be able to speak and write in the target language about their family, friends, and hobbies. Additionally, they will be able to order at restaurants, ask for directions, as well as ask and answer basic questions about themselves and others.

## **Foreign Language II-10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>**

This class picks up where Foreign Language I left off with continued study in listening comprehension, speaking, reading, writing, and culture. Lessons will pick up online where Spanish I left off and will be devoted to the study of various tenses, and expand students' vocabulary to allow them to discuss and write about a wider range of topics.

By the end of this course, students will be able to do everything they learned in level I, plus discuss and write about more abstract concepts, such as their aspirations for the future. Students will also be able to use the target language to talk with a doctor about an illness or go to a clothing store and discuss options with a store clerk.
