Huskie Families,

As many of you know, yesterday the MDHHS Order was extended for 12 additional days. Thus, requiring that grades 9-12 remain virtual until after Christmas Break.

**Last evening the Board of Education approved returning to Face-to-Face Instruction for PK-5th grades beginning on Wednesday, December 9th.** PK-5 students will be back for eight school days to finish out the semester. The elementary will have scheduled half days (7:45 am - 11:15 a.m.) on both Wednesdays (December 9th & 16th) and Friday, December 18th.

Also, K-5 will now be required to wear a mask. Students will be allowed mask breaks and can also remove when socially distanced or outside.

**At the middle school and high school, the decision has been made that grades 6-12th will remain virtual.** 6-12th grade students will continue to follow their current virtual schedule for the remaining eight days of the semester and we are very hopeful that they will return to Face-to-Face when we return from Christmas Break in January. **An option for our 6-12th grade students that we are able to offer is the ability for students to use the MS/HS Media Center to use the internet during the day.** Tutoring and academic assistance will also be available by appointment.

Transportation for the use of the internet will be available, however, it will follow the PK-5 school day schedule (7:45 to 11:15 on half days and 7:45 am - 2:45 pm on full days). Students will be picked up at their normal time and they will be sent home by 11:15 am on half days and 2:45 pm on full days. If you have questions regarding transportation, please contact Mr. Hillman.

**Grades 6-12th meals will be delivered on Tuesdays and Thursdays.** Meals will be delivered between 9 am and noon on Tuesdays and Thursdays. If you live in town, please pick up between 10 am and noon on Tuesdays or Thursdays or by appointment with Mrs. Collins

Until the MDHHS order is changed, all MS/HS athletics are postponed.

As our PK-5 students return, please remember to follow our COVID-19 protocol and health checks. **THANK YOU for continuing to be proactive to help mitigate the spread so we can all stay healthy and continue in person learning!**
